SUBJECT: Professional Standards Commission Rule Rescission/Amendment/Adoption

On March 9, 2023, the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC) initiated the rulemaking process to (1) **amend** the current rules in Chapter 505-3- Educator Preparation Rules, effective June 15, 2023, as follows: 505-3-.01, 505-3-.05, and 505-3-.06.

On May 11, 2023, the Commission repealed/amended/adopted the aforementioned rules, effective June 15, 2023.

Discussion (Educator Preparation)

505-3-.01 REQUIREMENTS AND STANDARDS FOR APPROVING EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROVIDERS AND EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAMS

This newly adopted rule removes and/or simplifies ambiguous terms, replaces the InTASC Model Core Teaching Standards with the Teacher Assessment on Performance Standards (TAPS), and clarifies language related to dyslexia and the teaching of reading.

505-3-.05 GEORGIA TEACHER ACADEMY FOR PREPARATION AND PEDAGOGY (GaTAPP)

This newly adopted rule removes and/or simplifies ambiguous terms.

505-3-.06 PEDAGOGY-ONLY PROGRAM

This newly adopted rule replaces national standards with state-developed standards for teacher performance.
